International Tender Invitation to Tender Central Tender No. (13/2024)

Al Kafrein Wells Assessment and Rehabilitation Project The Beneficiary Entity: Water Authority of Jordan (WAJ)

The Government Tenders Department (GTD, Procuring Entity) invites qualified international and Jordanian Construction Contractors eligible to the European Investment Bank (EIB) ("the bank"), that satisfy the qualification criteria set below, to submit tenders for the Al Kafrein Wells Assessment and Rehabilitation ("the Project"), as follows:

- Jordanian Construction Contractors classified by (GTD) as first Grade in the specialization of Wells Drilling;
 Or
- 2- International Contractors satisfy the below Qualification and Evaluation Criteria; Or
- 3- Joint Venture (JV) of contracting firms. The JV shall be limited to (2) members.

The Water Authority of Jordan (WAJ, The Beneficiary Entity) has signed a loan agreement with the EIB to fund Al Kafrein Wells Assessment and Rehabilitation Project. The tender procedure will be carried out according to the Government Procurement By-Law No.8 of 2022 and Instructions on Regulation of the Government Procurement Procedures, and in line with EIB Guidance to Procurement (GtP): https://www.eib.org/en/publications/guide-to-procurement.htm

1- Scope of Work

WAJ plans to perform an assessment of groundwater wells in Al Kafrein in the Jordan Valley to serve the localities in South Shouneh District. The project objective is to determine the current conditions of the groundwater wells and the aquifers to develop rehabilitation programs for the wells pumping systems (riser pipe, new pump, well head, metering and valves.... etc.) as necessary.

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The project includes the following components:

- An initial inspection program of 7 existing production wells.
- The reporting of findings and recommendations from the initial well inspection program for potential rehabilitation activity.
- A subsequent program for well rehabilitation works (existing production wells).
- · Post-rehab camera survey.
- Well performance (step drawdown) testing.
- 96-hour constant rate test for selected wells.
- Reinstatement.
- Other scope items.
- 2- The price of a copy of the tender documents is (250) JD (Non-refundable). Payment can be made through the **eFAWTEERcom** application, electronic payment via bank applications, or at the GTD chest located at the address noted below.
- 3- Tender documents can be collected by an authorized representative from GTD at the address noted below starting from March 7, 2024 up to March 18, 2024 or can be downloaded from Jordan online E-procurement system (JONEPS).
- 4- The last date for purchasing the Tender Documents is March 18, 2024 at 3:00 P.M. (Amman local time).
- 5- Bidders must registered on the Jordan online E-procurement system (JONEPS) (www.joneps.gov.jo). If you encounter any technical problem, please call the numbers 0788844565 and 0788844560 to register on the system from March 7, 2024.
- 6- The bidder shall provide the Supporting Unit of the Specialized Central Procurement Committee with the original copy of the tender security before 12:00 P.M. (Amman local time) on the same day of the submission date.







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- 7- The bidder shall provide as part of its tender, an unconditional tender security in the name of **His Excellency the Director General of the Government Tenders Department in addition to his post** in the amount of **20,000 USD**, and to be valid for a period of 120 days from the submission date.
- 8- The tender security shall be in the form of a bank guarantee from a Jordanian Bank or a Foreign Bank licensed to operate in Jordan. The format of the bank guarantee shall be in accordance with the sample form of the tender security included in the section 00410 of the tender documents and shall be on the letterhead of the issuing bank and shall be signed by a person competent to bind the bank. Any tender that is not accompanied by an enforceable and compliant tender security shall be rejected as not responsive. Certified Bank Cheques shall not be accepted.
- 9- The tender security of a Joint Venture or Association should be in the name of all partners of the Joint Venture or Association.
- 10- Bidders must submit their bids in the form of Technical Proposal and Financial Proposal in two separate sealed envelopes at the same time as follows:

Envelope No. 1, namely "Technical Proposal"

Envelope No. 2, namely "Financial Proposal"

Each envelop shall contain one original and two copies and one soft copy of the required respective documents, in accordance with the tender documents. The bidders shall provide as part of its tender, in a separate envelope, an unconditional tender security as stated above. GTD will not be responsible for lost and/or undelivered documents sent by mail, FedEx or similar means.

11- A two-day Pre-tender Conference will be held starting with a site visit to the location of Al Kafrein wellfield sites on **March 25**, **2024**. Interested bidders shall arrange for their own transportation and be available at 10:00 A.M. Amman local time in front of Al Kafrein Water Treatment Plant. 15-Qualification Requirements:

Jordanian contractors: provide classification certification by GTD as first Grade in the specialty of Wells Drilling.

International contractors provide evidence to satisfy the below qualifications:

• The Firm has been registered as a contractor for at least 5 years before the issue of this Invitation.







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The contractor has successfully performed at least 2 similar projects that includes assessments and rehabilitation of ground wells in the last ten years that included at least the assessment of 5 wells. Each contract value shall be more than Jordanian Dinar 0.5million or equivalent.

Jordanian and International contractors provide evidence to satisfy the below qualifications:

- The Firm has the qualified staff to perform the work within the organization (Names and CVs to be provided for at least 3 key staff that has more than 10 years of similar experience to the specified work)
- The Firm has the financial capacity to perform the required work. Certificate of Solvency issued by a financial institution (bank) certifies that the bank is prepared to provide the Contractor with credit facilities in the amount not less than JD 500,000 (Five Hundred Thousand Jordanian Dinars), as coverage allowance for 3 consecutive months. The Financial Institution shall be a Jordanian Bank or Foreign Bank licensed to operate in Jordan.
- The firm has the equipment or provide proof of the ability to provide required equipment if awarded the contract.

The contract will be awarded to the lowest price of the eligible, qualified, and responsive tenders, provided that the prices are considered reasonable.
